SSINA ANNOUNCES ELECTION OF NEW CHAIRMAN AND VICE CHAIRMAN

Washington, D.C. – Dr. Sunil Y. Widge, Chief Technology Officer Emeritus of Carpenter Technology Corporation (Carpenter), has been elected Chairman of the Specialty Steel Industry of North America (SSINA) and Carl R. Moulton, Vice President, International of Allegheny Technologies Incorporated (ATI), has been elected Vice Chairman. Dr. Widge and Mr. Moulton bring more than 65 years of combined steel industry experience to SSINA and will assume these new positions immediately.

Dr. Widge succeeds outgoing Chairman Douglas A. Kittenbrink, who has held the position since 2007. “We deeply appreciate the work that Doug has accomplished during his tenure leading the association,” said Dr. Widge. “As the incoming Chairman, I look forward to guiding SSINA and our member companies in response to the challenges facing the specialty steel industry.”

A 32-year veteran of Carpenter, Dr. Widge was recently named Chief Technology Officer Emeritus of the company. He began his career with Carpenter in 1976 and most recently served as Senior Vice President and Chief Technology Officer. In addition to leading process and product research and development in new materials applications, Dr. Widge’s responsibilities also included directing the expansion of the company’s high profile scientific capability in specialty alloy materials technology and promoting new products.

Dr. Widge earned a Ph.D. in Metallurgy and Material Science from Lehigh University in 1985, an MBA from the Wharton School of Business, University of Pennsylvania, in 1993, and a B.S. in Metallurgy from the College of Engineering in Poona, India. Dr. Widge holds five U.S. patents and serves on the Board of Directors of Alvernia University. He has also held various leadership roles and committee memberships with the American Society of Metals, the Metallurgy Society, the Industrial Research Institute, and the Special Materials Processing Consortium.

Carl R. Moulton serves as Vice President, International, at ATI, one of the largest and most diversified specialty metals producers in the world. Mr. Moulton’s responsibilities include

overseeing the company's commercial activities in Europe and Asia and the STAL Precision Rolled Strip® and Uniti titanium ventures.

A graduate of Dartmouth College, Mr. Moulton served in the U.S. Army as a First Lieutenant, earning a Bronze Star. Following his military career, Mr. Moulton worked as a sales representative with Allegheny Ludlum in 1972 before joining Jessop Steel in 1981. Mr. Moulton served as President of Jessop Steel when the company was acquired by ATI in 1993. During his tenure as President of Jessop, Mr. Moulton served on the Board of Directors at SSINA and also served as the association's Vice Chairman. Mr. Moulton currently serves on the Board of Directors of Uniti LLC, which has become one of the world's leading suppliers of industrial titanium products.
